Beaumont, Texas Concrete repairs to temporarily close a section of I-10

(Beaumont, TX) Highway workers will temporarily close a section of I-10 through Beaumont to make repairs to portions of the highway. The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) says the project involves replacing damaged sections of concrete on eastbound I-10 between College Street and Eastex Freeway.

On September 14th (Wednesday night) and September 15th (Thursday night), workers will close eastbound I-10 / northbound US 69 (Eastex) for repairs. The closure for Wednesday is scheduled for 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Thursday's closure is schedule for 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. All work is weather permitting. TxDOT says all eastbound traffic will exit US 90 and travel the frontage road to 11th Street. Eastbound I-10 traffic can reenter the interstate at 11th Street. Northbound US 69 traffic will use the 11th Street turnaround and reenter the highway at Delaware. All traffic signals along the detour will be set to flash yellow to help traffic flow.

The work is part of a three-county project to repair damaged concrete. Approximately 17 highways in Jefferson, Orange and Hardin Counties will be repaired. The \$785,000 project is expected to be complete in early October.

**Lane Closure Announcement: Highway 69/96 (Eastex Freeway)
Between Lucas and the LNVA Canal**

Beaumont, Texas – City of Beaumont crews will close the northbound and southbound inside lanes on a portion of Eastex Freeway, between Lucas and the LNVA Canal on Sunday, July 24, for freeway lighting repairs. It is estimated that this lane closure will occur for one day, from 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Access to both through and local traffic will be maintained throughout the closure. Motorists are advised to exercise caution and observe warning signs and barricades when traveling in the area.
